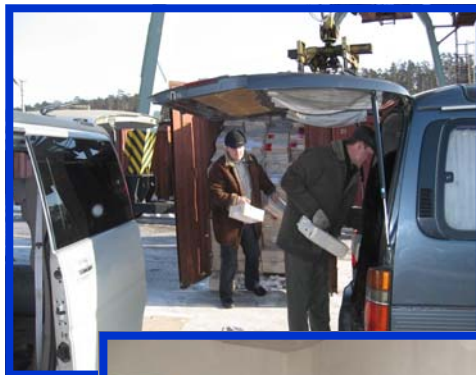
COUNTING DOWN Three Months To ITINERATION
